**ANY OTHER TOWN BUSINESS**

In response to a question from Fr Gott re Christmas Lighting the Clerk stated that it had been funded from *Amenities*

Fr Gott reported that work would begin shortly on creating a modular garden, DDA compliant, on the embankment adjacent to the Church for which support would be sought from Hebden Royd Town Council

An elector voiced concern over vehicle speeds in the New Road area of Mytholmroyd. Cllr Beacroft-Mitchell reported that as part of the Traffic Review for Mytholmroyd, Calderdale MBC Highways would be publishing draft plans for consultation over the summer period.

Fr Gott voiced concern re likelihood of flooding in the Hall Bank Lane/Elphin Brook area where previous measures had proved counter productive. Calderdale MBC and Yorkshire Water have joint responsibility at this location but the matter would be included in the Local Flood Plan considerations to be undertaken with Calderdale MBC and the Environment Agency in the next Council year.
