233. PUBLIC QUESTION TIME

Tony Litton asked the council to support a newly establish group called UCV Flood Prevention which aimed to highlight the experiences of those affected by the recent flooding. A website had been established and they were looking to secure a small amount of funding to develop their work.

236. LOCALISATION OF COUNCIL TAX SUPPORT

Ann Wardle, CMBC Head of Customer Services & Communications, presented on the impact of Localised Council Tax Support Schemes on Hebden Royd as part of the Local Government Finance Bill 2011.

These reforms are part of the Welfare Reform Agenda, replacing council tax benefits with discounts which will affect working age

recipients but not those of pensionable age (these people having rules defined by central government).

Calderdale MBC plan to finance the changes as follows:

2013/14 – from reserves (10% deficit)

2014/15 – Claimants pay a contribution (approx. 13.3% of liability plus changes to the rules.

2015/16 – new scheme being developed.

HRTC as a precepting authority will be effected as council tax base calculations will be altered (possible reduction of 500 for Hebden Royd) but this should be counteracted by a central government grant.

Councillors asked numerous information on subjects including streamlining and contacting disadvantaged families and individuals.
